

SJMGA Executive Council Meeting Minutes December 2, 2021

Tournament Related

- ACTION: Jim Freudenberg to query three members who cancelled early on Dec 2nd for excuses, and suspend playing privileges, if necessary
- ACTION: Jim Freudenberg to draft email reminder regarding late cancellation and play suspension policy. Brian to review and forward to SJMGA membership.
- Council agreed to schedule a DFL Tournament targeted to occur before year end. Past DFL Tournaments have allowed participants to have one mulligan per DFL flag received in the current calendar year.
- ACTION: Jim Freudenberg to work with Lee to schedule and align on rules for DFL Tournament

Christmas Luncheon

- Set to follow play on Dec 16th. All members invited.
- ACTION: Brian to invite KJ, Lee, and Kent to Christmas luncheon.

V Tees in Weekly SJMGA Events

- Discussed adding play from V tees to weekly SJMGA events
- Rationale
 - 247 of 384 SJMGA members older than 70. 115 members older than 75.
 - Feedback from members who will not longer join MGA without option of playing from V tees
- Council agreed to begin play from V tees in SJMGA events effective January 1, 2022
- Member will need to notify SJMGA and Troon tournament directors in early January 2022 of decision to play from V tees in SJMGA events
- Member will need to establish a handicap from the V tees as soon as possible, and then maintain the V tee handicap by posting 65% of scores from the V tees
- ACTION: Mike Hayes to draft email to membership outlining V tee change and member actions required

Other Business

- Paul Schnobrick reviewed 2021/22 SJMGA budget. Projected a deficit of about \$1300 for YE2021. Paul outlined steps in 2022 to reduce/eliminate the budget deficit.
- Council agreed to meet projected \$1300 deficit by transferring funds from BB&T savings account to BB&T checking account
- ACTION: Paul to arrange for additional SJMGA Council members be added to the BB&T signature cards
