2024 Budget Update: Jeff shared we have a \$13908.22 account balance. In addition, we have about \$390 credit book and YTD \$332 from the 50/50.

2024 Updated Roster: Jeff shared we have 359 paid members for 2024 with 36 new members. 2 members short paid again 2024.

Mailchimp & MGA Website: Mike shared that all new members have been added to Mailchimp. Meeting minutes from 3/21 need to be uploaded to the website.

Handicap Committee Update: Rich provided written input via email

- 1. The next Handicap Committee Meeting will be held on Monday, May 6th. We will review the current Monthly Posting Report (for the period of February, March, and April). I expect that (now that we have a full 3 months of data) that the Handicap Committee will again begin enforcing the 95% Posting Requirement. John Matter will share that information re: MGA Members (which as of this email) is not currently available.
